Ed was a fixture in the West Babylon Community and cared deeply about improving the lives of others through sport and the benefits that come from hard work and dedication. He also loved being a Gym teacher, especially working with Elementary students and their enthusiasm for Gym class. 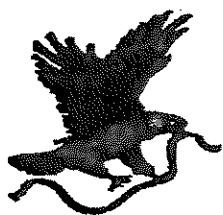

He played varsity football as an Eagle all four years of high school and earned All-County and All-Long Island. He also excelled in wrestling, which brought him all over the world. He was nationally ranked by the time he graduated WBHS and was a two-time New York State Champion. Sports, academics, and determination allowed him to be the first person in his family to attend college.

Alton was a friendly person and was always smiling. Although he faced some adversities in life, he positively impacted the lives of everyone around him. This scholarship is for a minority student who excels in both sports, and academics.
