13. OLD BUSINESS

West Babylon Transportation Scholarship Committee Request - Dr. Yiendhy Farrelly, Superintendent of Schools Mr. Hanley shared that Dr. Farrelly recently received a letter from the West Babylon Transportation Scholarship Committee regarding raising funds for their scholarships.
