Dr. Yiendhy Farrelly welcomed all to the new school year and the Board meeting. She also welcomed the students who were in attendance. This morning a delivery truck hit the JHS canopy. Dr. Farrelly shared that throughout the summer, we post pictures of our construction work on our website and on social media. We compiled an overview of Capital Project work completed, in progress and work that is upcoming.
