Kennedy School, is retiring effective June 30, 2019. Mr. Cunningham has agreed to be assigned to Forest Avenue Elementary School as a long term interim principal effective September 3, 2019. The Board of Education and Dr. Farrelly are confident he has the qualities to do an excellent job at Forest Avenue. Dr. Farrelly said there is a letter programed to go out tonight, through the School Messenger system at approx. 9:00 PM, to Forest Avenue parents/guardians regarding this situation. The reason for the 9:00 PM time is that certain contract approvals were on tonight's agenda.

Ms. Katherine Henning, West Babylon resident, Forest Avenue parent, expressed her concerns regarding the inconsistency at Forest Avenue school relative to the principal. She would like to know when a permanent principal will be assigned to the school. Dr. Farrelly was not able to provide an answer due to the personnel confidential/privacy nature of the issue.

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
