Procedural: B. Statement of the Board and/or Superintendent

Dr. Farrelly congratulated the district's 5th graders on their moving up ceremonies and shared how proud the Board and Administrators are on the students' accomplishments. Dr. Farrelly said she looks forward to cheering them on throughout their JHS career. We are all excited about the upcoming JHS graduation (Thursday night) and SHS graduation (Friday night) ceremonies. Dr. Farrelly also congratulated Mr. Hanley, Mrs. Psarakis and Mr. Payne -- each of whom have children who graduated this year. Mr. Hanley's son, Brennan, moved up from the 8th grade at Nesaquake Middle School to Smithtown East High School; Diana Psarakis graduated from Smithtown West High School; and Emily Payne graduated from Northport High School.

To answer an outstanding question from the June 11th Board meeting, per Dr. Vassallo - the total scholarship dollar amount awarded during the Senior Awards Ceremony was \$116,000. Dr. Farrelly thanked all the individuals and associations involved in recognizing our seniors. Dr. Farrelly shared that, on Tuesday, June 18th, she hosted the 2nd annual "Top 25 Blue & Gold Breakfast" with the top 25 SHS students and their invited guests (past/present teacher of their choice). It was a great morning and so wonderful to see the students engage with their guests. Pictures have been posted to the website as well as on Facebook. Dr. Farrelly plans on continuing this tradition. Dr. Farrelly also said this past month's classroom activities will be highlighted on social media.

On Friday, June 21st, in the Administration Office-Board Room, Dr. Farrelly, along with County Legislator Steve Bellone, SCPD Commissioner Geraldine Hart and SCPD Chief of Department Stuart Cameron, hosted a press conference regarding the district's participation in the SHARE Consent for Remote Electronic Device Access Agreement which enables the Suffolk County Police Department, as well as the Suffolk County Department of Fire, Rescue and Emergency Services (FRES), to have temporary remote access of electronic devices within the district in case of an emergency such as an active shooter situation. West Babylon and Elwood School District are in the process of working with Intralogic, internal staff and SCPD taking care of the "behind the scenes" work and the system should be operational in approximately two weeks. Dr. Farrelly said she will share with the Board when this occurs. Dr. Farrelly thanked Board President Lucy Campasano and Board Trustee Cathy Gismervik for joining her at the press conference.

Board President Lucy Campasano asked approximately how many staff personnel are participating in the "RAVE" Panic Button/Cellphone System. Mr. Hanley said about 800 employees have signed on with the cellphone RAVE app notification. This summer the system will be tested.

Dr. Farrelly said she provided the trustees with copies of the June 14, 2019 - Department of Health Statement on Legislation Removing Non-Medical Exemption from School Vaccination Requirements. Copies, located on the counter, were provided for the public as well. Mr. Payne and Mr. Spinelli, Director of Health, Physical Education & Nurses, have notified parents regarding the vaccination deadlines for children.

Discussion was held as to whether the 2019-2020 Board of Education photo should be taken at the August 27th or the September 10th Board meeting. The trustees were in agreement that the photo should be scheduled for the September 10th Board meeting.

Dr. Farrelly said she will be sending out a summer video, produced by Syntax, wishing all a good summer. She intends to ask the WB staff, faculty and community to send her pictures as to where they are over the summer for future posting.

3. REPORT OF THE SUPERINTENDENT AND/OR EDUCATIONAL PRESENTATION

Presentation: A. Math & Movement Presentation: Mr. Scott Payne, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum & Instruction; Mrs. Theresa Taplin, Math Curriculum Specialist

Dr. Farrelly introduced Mr. Payne and Mrs. Theresa Taplin, Math Curriculum Specialist. Mrs. Taplin had prepared a short PowerPoint presentation titled "Lowe's Toolbox for Education Grant". She explained that "Math & Movement" is a kinesthetic, multi-sensory approach to teaching math. It incorporates physical exercise, stretching, cross-body movements, yoga, and visually pleasing floor mats designed to encourage students to practice concepts. Last year, South Bay was a recipient of the \$5,000 grant from Lowe's Charitable and Educational Foundation. This year, Forest Avenue, JFK, Santapogue and Tooker elementary schools all are recipients of the 2018-2019 Lowe's Toolbox for Education grant. This money will purchase an entire set of "Math & Movement" mats and sponsor a "Math & Movement" Family Fun Night for each elementary school. Mrs. Taplin shared photos from the South Bay Family Fun Night where over 100 families from the 5 elementary schools, 12 teachers and 20 SHS students, participated. During the 2019-2020 school year, 4 Family Fun Nights will be scheduled - exact dates are not yet available. Mrs. Taplin said Mr. Dan McKeon and Mr. Michael Mack have ordered a set of the same mats for the summer school program. The presentation will be posted to the district website.
