BOARD OF EDUCATION REPORT(S): "Review of External Audit Procedures"

Mr. Anthony Cacciola introduced Mr. Michael Nawrocki of Nawrocki Smith LLP. Mr. Nawrocki stated the preliminary audit procedures were done in February 2010 and the final audit will take place in September 2010. Mr. Nawrocki stated the district has an excellent track record regarding timely filings with the state of New York. He further stated Board of Education agenda resolution #FI-2 relates to reaffirming and establishing reserves which is typical of other districts. Any reserves reflected have to be approved by the Board of Education prior to the fiscal year end (June 30<sup>th</sup>) and our district's format is appropriate. He noted the increase to the retirement funds and unemployment reserves proposal is normal. Mr. Nawrocki also welcomed Mr. Arthur Williams to West Babylon and stated he had worked with him previously and was looking forward to working with him again here in West Babylon. In response to Resident Raymond Cody's statement that the district was delinquent in completing the SED Comptroller's Report within the required timeframe, Mr. Cacciola stated the district requested and was granted an extension, by the SED, due to the fire incident at South Bay School. The report was completed and forwarded to the SED within the extended timeframe. In response to Resident Renee Elder's question, Mr. Cacciola has been appointed as the district purchasing agent for only a two week period — until Mr. Arthur Williams assumes the position of Executive Director for Finance & Operations. Resident Renee Elder discussed Newsweek's recent article "America's Best High Schools". Dr. Palma stated we encourage students to take AP (Advanced Placement) courses and the AP exams. The grades in the AP courses are weighted more heavily if a student takes the exam. He further stated our AP teachers take professional development in-service courses to improve instruction. Trustee Wendy DeGaetano stated our district offers AP classes to 9<sup>th</sup> graders.
